NURSING ADMISSION STANDARDS

Application to EvCC and admission to EvCC's Nursing Program are **separate procedures**. Students are selected for the Nursing Program each academic quarter: Fall, Winter, Spring. Only applicants who submit a completed application are considered for acceptance into the program. A Nursing File Establishment of \$50 will be assessed. Students pay this fee at the Cashier's office and present the receipt with their submission of Application Part I to the Nursing Records Office.

FOUR YEAR DEGREE OPTIONS

The RN to BSN Program is suited for nurses who have completed an Associate's Degree or Diploma nursing program and who already have their RN license. ADN students graduating by June are eligible to apply for "Conditional Admission", pending completion of ADN program and RN licensure.

CAREER AND EMPLOYMENT OPTIONS

Graduates receive an Associate in Arts and Science – Option I Degree after which they must satisfactorily complete the NCLEX-RN to become a Registered Nurse. After four quarters of nursing, students may apply for a Certificate in Practical Nursing, after which they must satisfactorily complete the NCLEX-LPN to become Licensed Practical Nurses. Licensed graduates are qualified for employment as entry-level nurses.
